

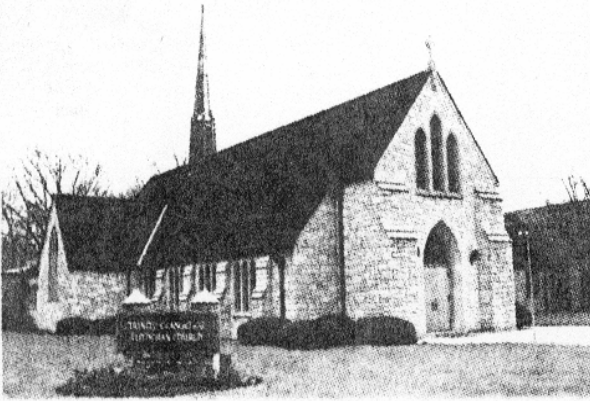

Easter is the Queen of Feasts in the church and the Sundays in April culminate with Easter at the end of the month. Lent continues to point the way during April and then, we remember Palm Sunday and Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. That day is also Confirmation Sunday for us at the 11:00 a.m. service. We invite you to join our eight young people in affirming their baptism. The following week is the holiest week in the Christian Church Year, aptly named Holy Week.

Maundy Thursday, April 21<sup>st</sup> we will have two services of Holy Communion at 10:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. At the evening service we will have 12 representatives of the congregation participate in the Footwashing rite. April 22<sup>nd</sup>, Good Friday, we will have a service at 11:00 a.m. that will focus on the Passion according to St. John. We will have our annual Tenebrae service at 7:00 p.m.

Our Easter schedule begins on Saturday evening at 5:30 p.m. with a version of the Easter Vigil. We invite you to come for this special service that focuses on baptism and Easter. The service and sermon will be different from Easter morning. Easter morning our schedule is:

## **From the Pastor**

Easter and spring seem synonymous most years, although some early Easters can be quite chilly and rainy, even having snow showers. Since Easter comes about as late as it can on the last Sunday in April we can anticipate a mild Easter, perhaps even an Easter that is warm and sunny – spring-like. Lent is from an old Anglo-Saxon word meaning “to lengthen” and linked to mean spring as the days become longer. Yet, it is Easter with spring dresses and hats, Easter parades, Easter egg hunts, Easter bunnies and chicks, and spring flowers that most conjures up images of spring. Also, we have the themes of renewal and new birth that seem to bring Easter and spring together.

Like spring that grows slowly out of winter, Easter moves gradually from Ash Wednesday through Lent to Palm Sunday and then through Holy Week. We get prepared and ready. We remember death, that we are “dust and to dust we shall return.” Lent leads us to contemplate sin and death and our need for repentance and God’s grace. Palm Sunday and Holy Week bring us to the reality of Jesus’ suffering and death on the cross. Even our Confirmation affirmation of faith is done under the shadow of the cross. Then, the lilies come out; the Paschal candle is lit; the eggs are colored; the music changes from somber to bright tones; we take the “Hallelujahs” out of the attic and adorn them from the rafters. Just like the temperatures gradually warm until we realize that spring is here; it seems that Easter is suddenly here.

Easter should seem like it is suddenly here because that is what resurrection does. We know that we will die someday. Although death seems unexpected and sudden sometimes – even though we prepare for it – we know that death is coming and it overshadows everything else. Resurrection springs forth suddenly and surprisingly. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! On Good Friday nobody expected Easter. It was Friday, but Sunday was coming. Resurrection jumps out of us just as Jesus broke out of the tomb and it was empty. God breaks the power of death and often we are not really ready for that. Death becomes comfortable even expected. God does something new and unexpected. Suddenly, Jesus is raised from death and everything is new and different. There is hope for a bright, sunny, warm new day. Life is brought forth from death. It is a new world brighter than any spring day.

Enjoy these warmer days as spring unfolds. The sometimes chilly nights, even days, remind us that spring comes gradually, but it comes. Easter seems that way too until we realize just what Easter is all about: life out of death. Resurrection! Enjoy spring. Enjoy Easter. But don’t confuse the two. Spring and summer turn to fall and winter every year. Although our church seasons and holy days mimic this seasonal turning, Easter is something new and different. Easter means that life is forever changed. Life is eternal for those who believe. God is bringing us God’s new day!

Enjoy your spring and have happy warm days of bright sunshine. Have a blessed Easter full of God’s new life no matter what happens. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

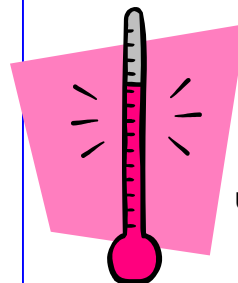


**Vision Committee update...**
